The Board

1. Sets priorities and goals for the organization
2. Carries out overall planning and decision making with input from committees and membership
3. Receives, reviews and approves/denies proposals for all new activities
4. Supports membership, development and visibility activities
5. Promotes the League in Marquette County
6. Safeguards the League's reputation for nonpartisanship

Board Members

1. Attend and participate in all board meetings
2. Become knowledgeable about the League
3. Aim to be aware of the full scope of the current work and activities of LWVMC
4. Explain and promote the League in Marquette County
5. Understand and abide by the League principle that for all national, state and local advocacy efforts the League speaks with one Voice
6. Understand and abide by the League's nonpartisan policy
7. Understand and support the League's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion policy
8. Get to know and engage membership
9. Identify and mentor new leaders
10. Promote growth and diversity in membership
11. Carry out individual assignments
12. May hold up to 3 consecutive 2 year terms

Board Focus and Liaison Responsibilities
